## Association For Rural Action, Chennai, INDIA.

AFRA is a registered Society with a heart to uplift the rural poor and down trodden. MSM and AFRA have a long standing relationship, we first met Joseph and Rosie Kumar who run the home 14 years ago. AFRA was started by Joseph's mother in a small two room dwelling, when she died Joseph felt led to leave his job in Dubai and return to care for the children. AFRA cares for up to 50 children/young people aged between 4 and 22 years, a number are supported through their Rural Children Development Project enabling them to stay with their families but receive help with education fees, transport and medical costs. AFRA are passionate about providing the best educational opportunities to help each child reach their potential. In addition they run a day care centre for the children of poor local families, outreach to the leprosy mission and a Sunday School Program for rural children.

Recently AFRA lost a major sponsor and are experiencing increasing difficulty in meeting the running costs. MSM are keen to raise additional support and awareness for this very worthwhile project.

### **VALUES AND OBJECTIVES**

Mustard Seed Ministries is a registered charity established in 1993, whose inspiration and values derive from a faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and the truths contained in Scripture. Committed to working in partnership with the broader church worldwide to bring change to the lives of individuals and communities through prayer and mission rooted in practical love. Currently we are working in India, Bangladesh and the Philippines, supporting churches, orphanages, care homes and missionaries. Our aim is not to own or badge these projects, but to support local people at the cutting edge who know, care and understand the problems they face. Alongside financial support MSM offer practical and spiritual help and seeks to develop relationships between projects for mutual support, encouragement and the sharing of resources.

The aim of the home is to offer children with special needs a loving and encouraging environment with appropriate education and training to enable them to express their talents and become, where possible, independent and self supporting adults. There are currently 10 resident plus those who receive respite care and support.




#### **VILLAGE MINISTRY:**
