SAMO SALAMON - guitar (SLOVENIA)

Samo Salamon is »one of the most talented young guitarists and composers to emerge on today's jazz scene« (Allmusic.com). So far he has recorded and played with many great jazz musicians like John Scofield, Paul McCandless, John Hollenbeck, Mark Turner, Michel Godard, Tim Berne, Dominique Pifarely, Donny McCaslin, Nguyen Le, Drew Gress, Tony Malaby, Mark Helias, Tom Rainey, Dave Binney, Josh Roseman, Gerald Cleaver, Julian Arguelles, John Hebert, Loren Stillman, John O'Gallagher, Carlo DeRosa, Tyshawn Sorey, Bruno Chevillon, Manu Codjia, Mikkel Ploug, Alex Machacek, Matt Brewer, Luciano Biondini, Dejan Terzic, Roberto Dani, Rudi Mahall, and others. So far he has recorded more than 160 original compositions that were released on 16 albums as a leader for labels, such as Steeplechase, Fresh Sound New Talent and Splasch Records.

MANU CODJIA - guitar (FRANCE)

Manu Codjia is one of the best young jazz guitarists in Europe and winner of several jazz awards as a soloist. He released 4 CDs as a leader for Bee Jazz and is playing as a sideman in numerous groups, such as Erik Truffaz Ladyland, Daniel Humair Baby Boom 5tet, Matthieu Donarier Trio, Henri Texier "Strada" Sextet, Guergui Kornazov Quintet, Dr. Knock, Remi Vignolo Quartet and others.

MIKKEL PLOUG - guitar (DENMARK)

Mikkel Ploug is one of Europe's best jazz guitarists, having recorded 5 albums for Fresh Sound New Talent and Songlines Recordings. He's playing regularly with jazz musicians like Mark Turner, Loren Stillman, Bill McHenry, Pete Robbins, Jeppe Skovbakke, Joachim Badenhorst, Sissel Vera Pettersen, Rebecca Collins, Marlon Browden, Sean Carpio, Kresten Osgood, Anders Christensen, Mikkel Hess, Niels Lykkegaard, Kenny Wheeler, Eivind Opsvik, Tommy Crane, Simon Jermyn, Jakob Dinesen and others.
