GOOD TO KNOW

- The album concept is based on a story written by guitar player Joey Siedl. The full story will be released as 150-page-softcover book.

CHEENO was founded by live and studio musicians of "Autumnblaze", a band which released 6 CDs worldwide via Prophecy Productions / Soulfod and played four full tours throughout Europe (among others, with Oceansize, Antimatter, The Vision Bleak). Along with Jennie Kloos, an experienced vocal soloist who previously performed for various big projects (such as the Munich Symphonics – Circus meets Classic) and for different TV- and advertisement productions (including Star Search Germany, TUI and the "Deutsche Kinderkrebsstiftung"), they formed a band together in August 2005. CHEENO was born.

One month after the first rehearsal sessions, they joined their former label mates Klimt1918 (IT) on their tour through Germany and The Netherlands. Until the end of 2005, CHEENO had won several newcomer contests and at the beginning of 2006, they published their first EP "try to rescue". The title track "the ruler" was rotating at the German radio station "Das Ding" for five weeks. Due to the band's heavy live presence (more than 50 concerts per year), CHEENO managed to gain a Europe-wide fan (Italy, Switzerland, The Netherlands, France).

In 2006, CHEENO competed with 800 bands to be nominated for the "German Rock and Pop" award. The band got in effortlessly and was finally awarded "Best Alternative Act 2006" with their song "Silizium".

In 2007, the band played as many live gigs supporting Paul Dianno (ex-Iron Maiden), Ross the Boss (ex-Manowar), Powerwolf, Mercenary, Xandria and many more in front of an average of 1000 people. In addition to these explosive rock shows, CHEENO started holding special unplugged sessions in 2007 that sold out completely.

In Summer 2008, CHEENO signed a worldwide record deal with Prevision Music, a sub division of Supreme Chaos Records, to release their first full length album "The Next Step Will Be The Hardest".
