Film Synopsis:

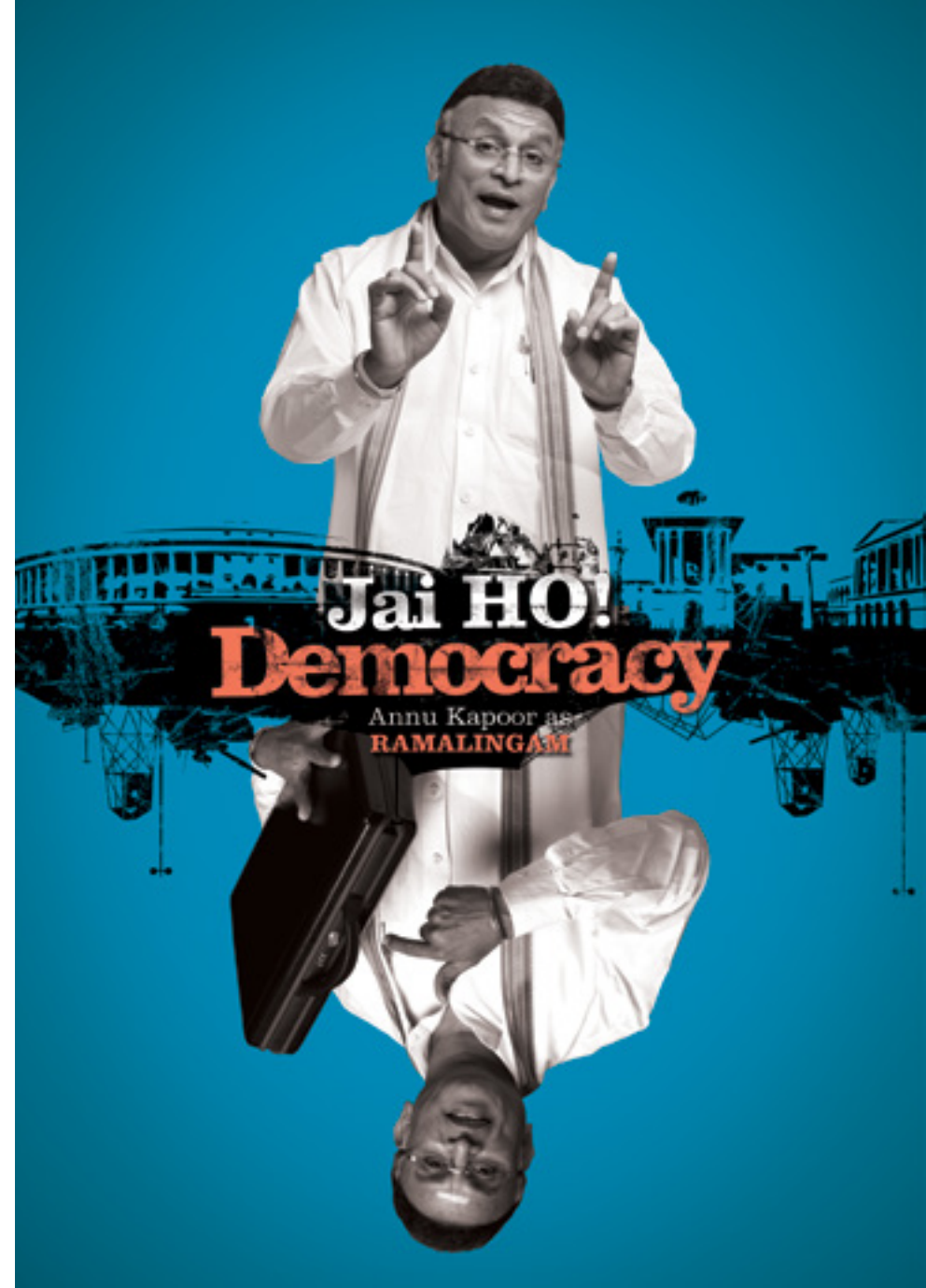

AGE: 65

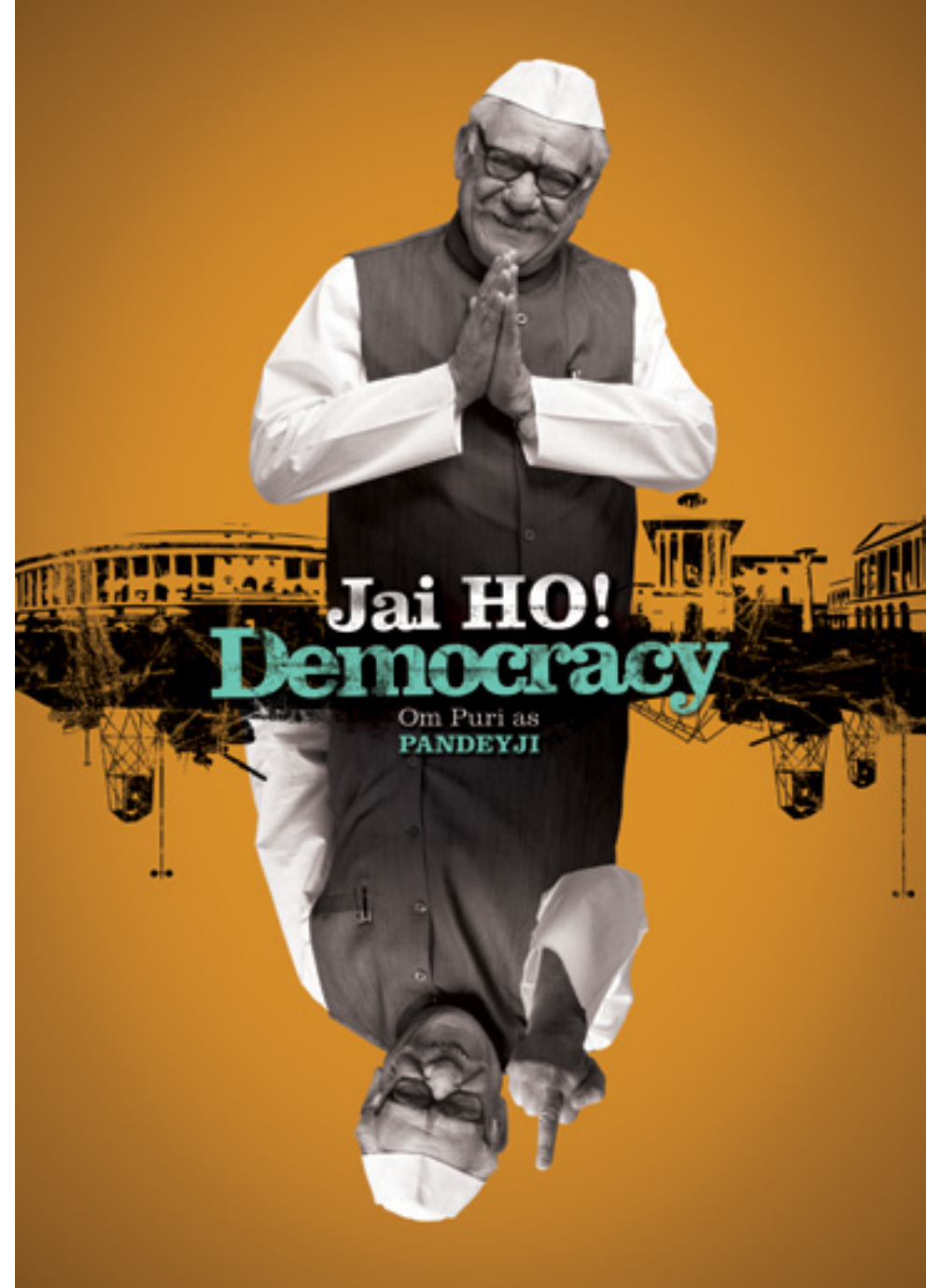
Ramalingam has always had very close relation with successive governments and has been rewarded by successive governments for his services in the capacity of a judge in various courts of law.

AGE: 71

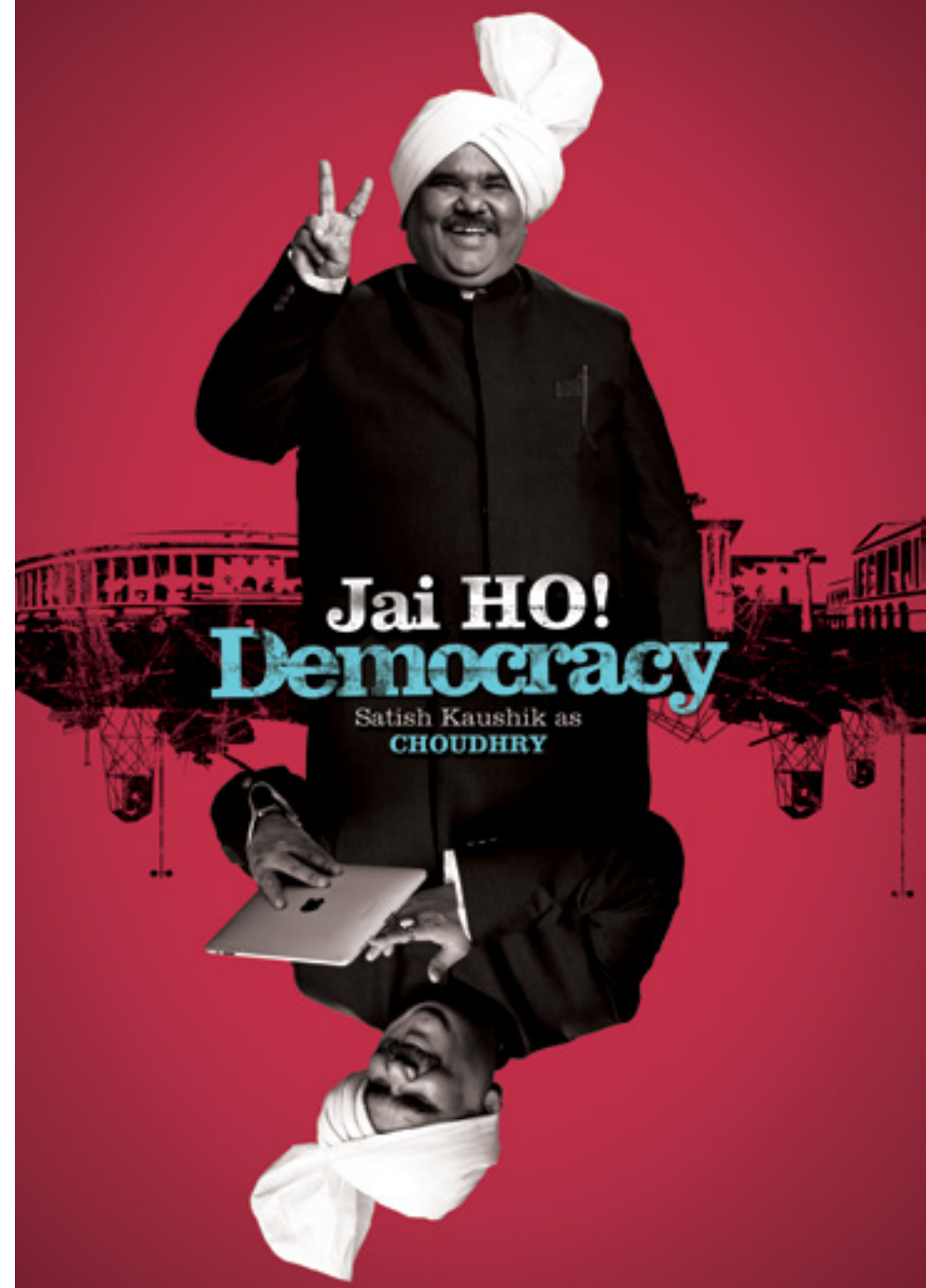
A right-wing heavyweight, he has come up the hard way in politics and is a relic of the prototype that defined the post-independence image of a desh politician.

AGE: 60

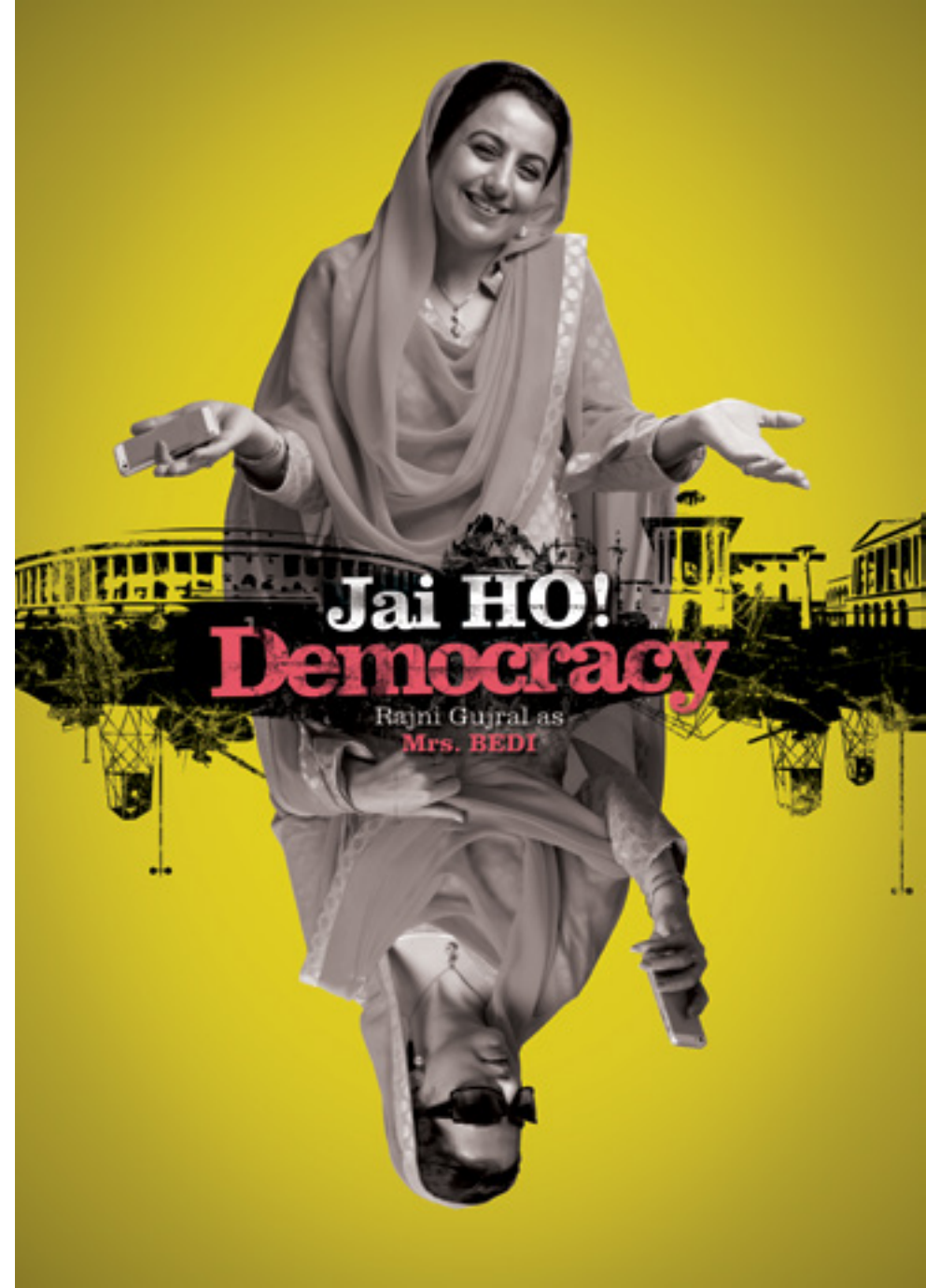

AGE: 41

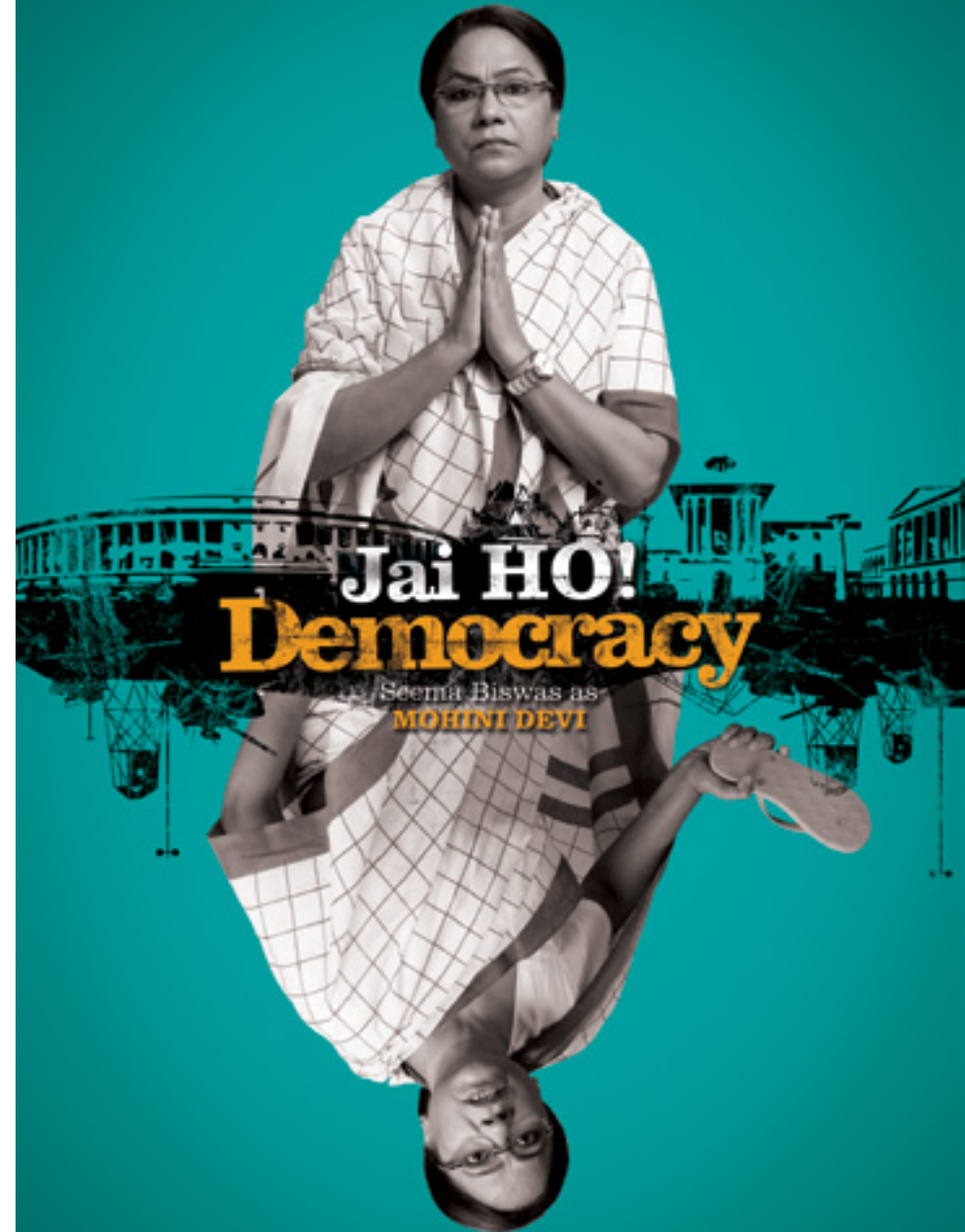

AGE: 54

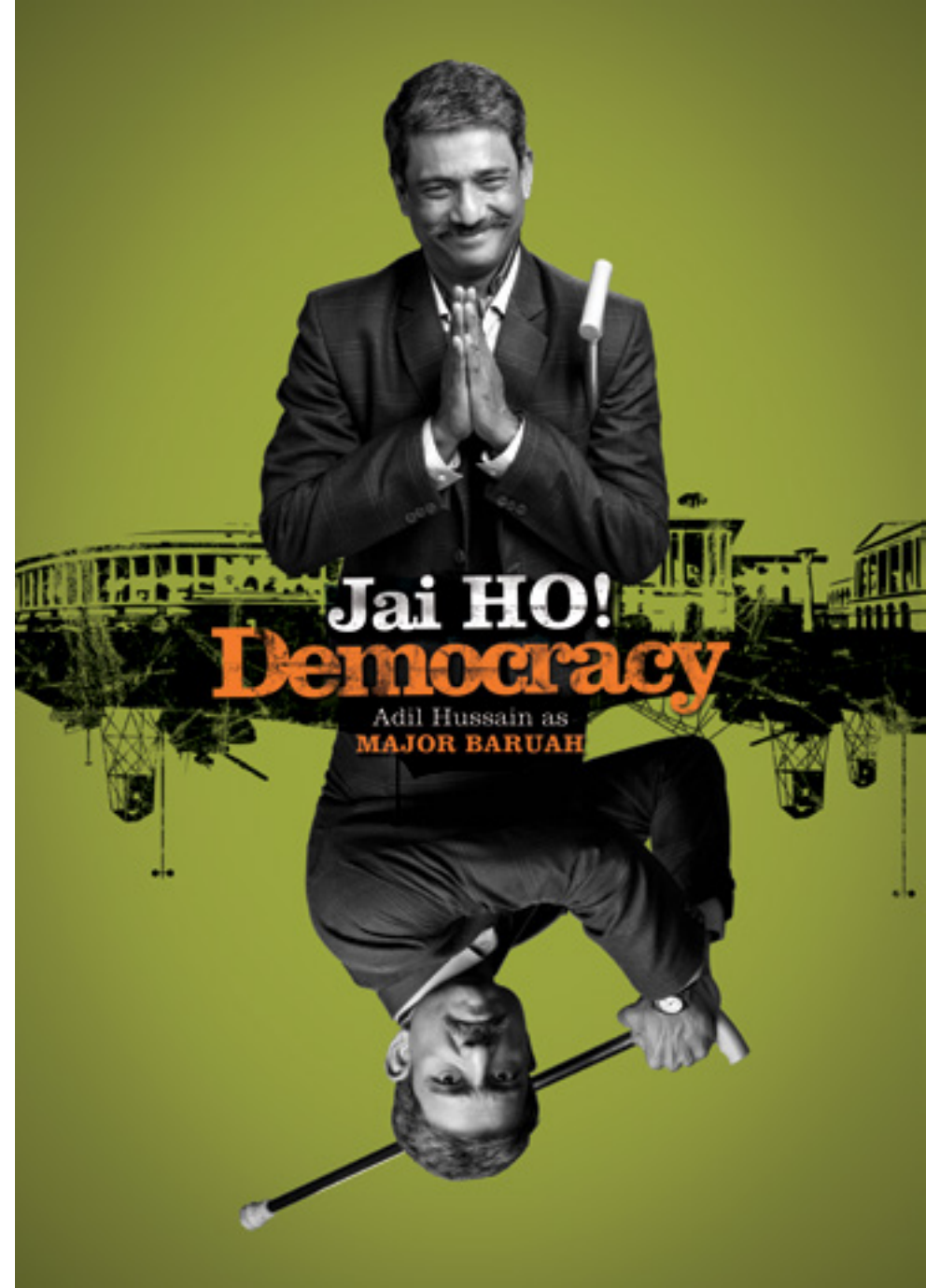

AGE: 49

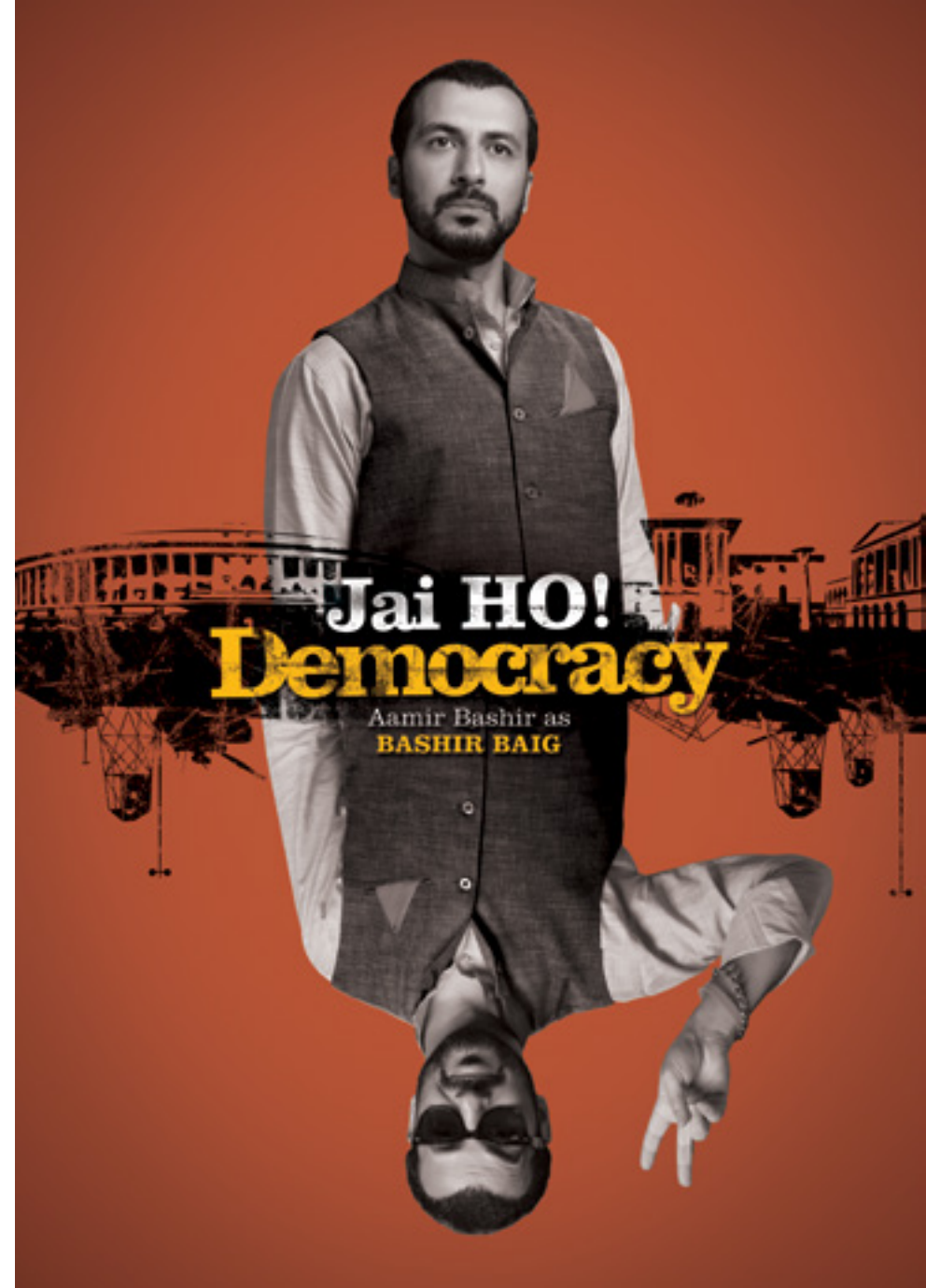
