The band originally formed 1979


Single 7" EP double A Side EP with Teesside band Discharge

The Filth started life as a local band. They soon built a strong following in, and around Teesside playing youth clubs, Their first gig was at Whinney Banks Youthy. Other Gigs included; Kader Youth Club, Acklam. Dene Youthy, Thornaby. Bishopsgarth Youthy, Stockton. (Endo got jumped outside). In 1979, played a few local pubs; The Commercial, The Teessider etc. Supported UK Subs at the Rock Garden in Middlesbrough 1980



The current line up got together in 2013 to play a charity event "A Night for Niggsi". This event featured lots of original Teesside punk bands getting back together to celebrate the life of Niggsi Johnson, the original Filth guitarist. The gig took place at the Georgian Theatre Stockton on Tees. Good friend of the band Jonny Baines stood in for Niggsi and ended up staying with the band to the present day.
